



## **Decision Criteria for Awarding District Simplified Grants**

### **2019-2020 Rotary Year**

1. For grants awarded in May of 2019, a club must have reached a minimum \$25 per capita donation to the Rotary Foundation's Annual Program Fund during 2017-2018.
2. Clubs can apply for a scholarship **OR** a project DSG.
3. To be fair to all clubs in the district, project DSGs, may not exceed \$4,000. A maximum of \$1,000 may be awarded for a DSG scholarship application.
4. For larger projects, clubs are encouraged to network with area clubs for support.
5. A history of successful completion of grants will be considered by the committee in awarding grants.
6. The Club must be qualified, by having sent two members to a Grant Management Seminar during the 2018-2019 year and, executing the 2019-2020 Memorandum of Understanding and District Addendum. For Clubs with fewer than 20 members, the Club's Foundation Area Director or the Assistant Governor may serve as one of the two required to attend a GMS.
7. Clubs that fail to complete their projects by the due date may not receive a grant for the following year. It will be the decision of the committee if non-completion of the project was beyond the club's control.
8. Final application must be post marked by April 1, 2019 to be considered. Late Applications will be returned unopened.
